





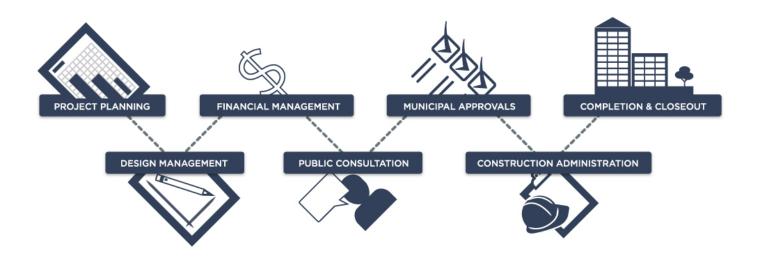








OUR SERVICES

CURRENT PROJECTS

Some of CPA's active projects include:

SW Marine Drive, Vancouver

Working with the Vancouver Affordable Housing Agency and New Chelsea Society to develop 102 units of affordable housing, with 56 units for families and 46 units for seniors.



Kinghaven III, Abbotsford

Working with Kinghaven Peardonville Housing Society on Phase III of the Society's campus redevelopment, which includes 60 additional units of supportive housing, along with program space and a new commercial kitchen with capacity to serve the needs of the entire campus.



Maple Ridge Pitt Meadows Community Services

Working with Maple Ridge Pitt Meadows Community Services to develop 94 units of affordable housing and 20,000 sq. ft. of office and programming space in Maple Ridge.



North Court Redevelopment, Tsawwassen

Working with KinVillage Association to develop 152 units of affordable housing for seniors. The project also includes a 25-space Day Program for Older Adults and office space for KinVillage administrative staff.

Buckley Avenue, Squamish

Working with Sea to Sky Community Services Society to develop 76 units of affordable rental housing and a 5,500 sq. ft. Foundry youth hub space.



Inclusion Homes, Powell River

Working with Powell River Inclusive Housing Society to develop 42 units of affordable rental housing with 100% of the units being designed as adaptable and 4 fully accessible units for residents with mobility challenges.



Hastings Street, Burnaby

Working with S.U.C.C.E.S.S. Affordable Housing Society to develop 161 units of affordable rental housing along with 20,000 sq.ft. of commercial space, including provisions for a 74 space daycare to be operated by the YMCA.



The Paramount, Chilliwack

Working with Chilliwack Community Services to develop 66 units of affordable rental housing, 15,650 sq. ft. of office and programming space and 2,750 sq. ft. of street-fronting commercial space.

Storeys, Richmond

Worked with all levels of government and five non-profit agencies to develop 129 units of a mix of housing types, a mental health clubhouse, a community centre, non-profit office space and a social enterprise cafe in Richmond.



The View, Vancouver

Worked with BC Housing and the Bloom Group Community Services Society to convert a former remand centre into 96 units of affordable housing in the Downtown Eastside of Vancouver.



Evergreen Terraces, White Rock

The development of a Fraser Health Authority funded 199-bed long term residential care home for the Evergreen Baptist Care Society in White Rock.



Hearthstone Place, Abbotsford

Worked with BC Housing and Archway Community Services to develop 31 units of supportive housing in Abbotsford.
